



Privacy statement

Webshop purchase

The personal information you forward to FitQueen webshop will be used to assure you the best service.

In order for you, as a customer, to make a purchase of goods at www.fitqueens.nl you are required to register the following information:

- Name
- Address
- Tel. No.
- E-mail address

The information is registered and kept for the purpose of delivering goods to your address. When gathering this information via our website, we do so only at your consent. The details are passed on to the delivery/shipping company solely for the purpose of delivering your order.

As a registrant with Fit Queen you have the legal right to know which information are stored. Any enquiries regarding this should be addressed to FitQueen by e-mail on support@fitqueens.nl

For the safety of your personal information, FitQueen webshop uses a secure connection to encrypt information passed to and from the website during registration and checkout. When paying an order, you can immediately check the security validity by clicking the padlock icon that appears in the URL line of your browser window when SSL is activated.

Information We Collect

In running and maintaining our website we may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information about your use of our site including details of your visits such as pages viewed and the resources that you access. Such information includes traffic data, location data and other communication data.
- Information provided voluntarily by you. For example, when you register for information or make a purchase.
- Information that you provide when you communicate with us by any means.

Use of Cookies

Cookies provide information regarding the computer used by a visitor. We may use cookies where appropriate to gather information about your computer in order to assist us in improving our website. We may gather information about your general internet use by using the cookie. Where used, these cookies are downloaded to your computer and stored on the computer's hard drive. Such information will not identify you personally. You can adjust the settings on your computer to decline any cookies if you wish. This can easily be done by activating the reject cookies setting on your computer. We do not allow commercial advertising on the Fit Queen Website and hence do not provide permission of the use of cookies by third parties.

Use of Your Information

We use the information we collect from you to provide services to you. In addition to this we may use the information for one or more of the following purposes:

- To provide information to you that you request from us relating to details of activities relating to our organisation
- To provide information to you relating to specific information that may be of interest to you. Such additional information will only be provided where you have consented to receive such information. Such information include newsletters and media products
- To inform you of any changes to our website, activities, products and other useful information regarding the Fit Queen Webshop.

Where your consent has been provided in advance we may allow selected third parties to use your data to enable them to provide you with information regarding products or information which we believe may interest you. Where such consent has been provided it can be withdrawn by you at any time.

Storing Your Personal Data

In operating our website, it may be necessary to transfer data that we collect from you for processing and storing. By providing your personal data to us, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We do our utmost to ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to make sure that your data is treated securely. Unfortunately the sending of information via the internet is not totally secure and on occasion such information can be intercepted. We cannot guarantee the security of data that you choose to send us electronically and therefore sending such information is entirely at your own risk.

- To further fraud protection and reduce the risk of fraud.
